## Program Review Baseline Data Notes and Definitions

<b>Faculty</b>
Faculty FTE is calculated using full-time plus 1/3 of part-time headcount. Graduate Assistant FTE is 1/4 of the sum of the percent employed value for each member of the group.
<b>Enrollment, Undergraduate</b>
Undergraduate FTE is calculated for primary and dual majors using full-time plus 1/3 of part-time headcount. For double majors, the FTE is calculated using (full-time headcount * 0.5) plus ((1/2 part-time)/3). The FTE for minors is calculated using (full-time headcount * 0.1) plus ((part-time*0.1)/3).
<b>Enrollment, Graduate/Professional</b>
Graduate/Professional FTE is calculated using full-time plus 1/3 of part-time headcount.
<b>Student Credit Hours</b>
Student Credit Hours calculation is based upon the reporting standard of the New England Commission of Higher Education (NECHE).
<b>Time to Degree</b>
Time to Degree (Bachelor's): The median of Time to Degree was calculated using first-time full-time freshmen Cohort at Storrs. There are 3 terms in each fiscal year. For example, FY 07-08 includes Summer 2007, Fall 2007, and Spring 2008. In the calculation, only the undergraduate students persisting in the same academic plan were chosen.  Time to Degree (Master's and Doctoral) : It is the median of Time to Degree for 3 terms in each fiscal year. For example, FY 07-08 includes Summer 2007, Fall 2007, and Spring 2008. In the calculation, only full-time, first time graduate students persisting in the same academic plan were chosen.
<b>Undergraduate Alumni Outcomes</b>

Percentages are out of respondents that graduated in the major during the listed academic year, which may be less than the number of graduates.
